# Caring For Your Floors ~ Laminate

## Cleaning

The "<u>Do</u>"s:

- Vacuum or sweep floors before cleaning, to remove dust and dirt.
- Use a microfibre mop to help avoid scratching the floor.
- Spray a light mist of water.
- Clean the floor in **small sections**.
- A neutral pH, non-toxic cleaner can also be used.

#### The "<u>Don't</u>"s:

- Do not use a wet mop on the floor.
- Do not use scouring pads or chemicals that may contain abrasives, soaps, waxes, ammonia or silicon.
- Do not use steam mops (regardless of what product sales people may say), or any form of scrubbing machine.

# **General Care Tips**

- Use a dry mop / dust mop regularly to help remove any dirt that may damage the floor.
- Wipe up any spills as soon as possible to avoid damage.
- Furniture legs, such as on **chairs**, should have **felt pads** to help avoid scratches.
- Heavy objects should be lifted not dragged.
- Some footwear, such as high heel shoes, may also damage the floor.
- Pets should have paws kept clean and nails trimmed to minimise any damage.
